IAT conducted its 40th Annual General Body Meeting for the year 2011-12 on 29th December 2012 at Dr. H.R. Arakeri Auditorium of the Institution

IAT conducted its 40th Annual General Body Meeting for the year 2011-12 on Saturday the 29th December 2012 at 2-30 P.M. at Dr. H.R. Arakeri Auditorium of the Institution. The President Dr. K.V. Sarvesh who presided over the meeting extended a warm welcome to the members who participated in the Annual General Body Meeting.

The deliberations of the AGM are as follows.

Proceedings of the 40th Annual General Body Meeting of the Institution of Agricultural Technologists, Bangalore for the year 2011-12, held on Saturday the 29th December 2012 at 2-30 P.M. at Dr. H.R. Arakeri Auditorium of the Institution.

The members assembled for the Annual General Body meeting at 2-30 P.M. and 462(Four hundred and sixty two) members as against the total membership strength of 3495 (Three thousand four hundred ninety five only) were present in the Annual General Body Meeting. As the number was satisfying the quorum requirement, the President Dr.K.V.Sarvesh who presided over the AGM called the 40th AGM to order.

(1) Welcome: The Secretary Sri. K.J. Devendrappa extended warm welcome to all the members present and requested the President to preside over the meeting. Further deliberations were carried out as per the agenda.

The President Dr. K.V. Sarvesh who presided over the meeting declared the 40th Annual General Body Meeting open.

(2) To read the notice calling for the 40th Annual General Body meeting of the Institution.

Sri. K.J. Devnedrappa, Secretary of the Institution read the meeting notice dated.16th November 2012

calling for the 40th Annual General Body Meeting of the Institution.

(3) Confirmation of the proceedings of the 39th Annual General Body Meeting held on 01-10-2011 and action taken there off.

The Secretary placed the 39th AGM proceedings held on 1st October 2011 before the August body and requested to confirm the proceedings.

Dr. K.V. Sarvesh, President, requested the August body to offer comments if any on the proceedings of the 39th AGM held on 1st October 2011. Since there were no comments. Dr. B.S. Nadagoudar proposed for adoption and was seconded by Dr. Challaiah.

The General Body unanimously approved the proceedings including the action taken thereoff.

(4) To consider and adopt the Annual Report for the period ending March 2012.

The Secretary presented the Annual Report of activities of the Institution for the year 2011-12 as furnished in pages 9 to 29 of the AGM report and sought the approval of the August Body. Sri.Shobana Murthy, Senior IATian proposed for approval of the Annual Report and was seconded by Sri.G.Gurusiddaiah.

The house unanimously approved to adopt the Annual Report for the year 2011-12.

(5) To consider and adopt the Annual Balance Sheet, as on 31st March 2012 and Income and Expenditure account.

(a) Receipts and Payments and Income and Expenditure

The Treasurer, Sri. K. Krishnappa while presenting the auditors report pertaining to the Receipts and Payments accounts, Income and Expenditure accounts and the Balance Sheet for the year 2011-12, as furnished in pages 31 to 40 of the AGM report, requested the august body to approve the same.

Dr. M. Mallappa, former Director of Agriculture and a senior IATian proposed for adoption of the Annual Balance Sheet and Dr.T.K.Prabhakar Setty former Director of Research, UAS(B) and a senior IATian seconded the approval.

The General Body unanimously accepted the Balance Sheet as on 31-03-2012, including the Receipts, Payments and Income and Expenditure Statements for the year 2011-12.

(b) Ratification of Expenditure incurred by the M.C. during the year 2011-12 exceeding the powers of M.C.

The Treasurer Sri.K.Krishnappa requested the General Body, to ratify the payment of Rs.2,30,000/- (Two lakes thirty thousand) to IAT Regional Chapter, Chitradurga for Extension/ Renovation of IAT Building for its better utilization.

Sri. G. Gurusiddaiah proposed for adoption and Dr. Prabhakar Setty seconded.

The General Body unanimously ratified the payment of Rs.2.30 lakhs made to IAT Regional Chapter, Chitradurga.

(6) To approve the budget for the year 2012-13.

The Treasurer, Sri.K.Krishnappa, presented the budget proposal for the year 2012-13 as furnished in pages 41 and 42 of the AGM booklet and sought the approval of the General Body.

Dr.Shivamurthappa proposed for approval which was seconded by Dr. B.S. Nadagoudar. The General Body unanimously approved the budget proposal for the year 2012-13.

(7) To appoint Auditors to audit the accounts for the year 2012-13 and fix their remuneration.

The Treasurer Sri.K.Krishnappa, proposed for the continuation of the present auditors M/s.Lakshmipathaiah and Co. for the year 2012-13 and to pay their remuneration depending on the work load and financial transactions.

Dr.Shivamurthappa proposed for adoption which was seconded by Dr. Shanthamallaiah.

The General Body unanimously approved to continue the present auditors for the year 2012-13 and to pay their remuneration.

(8) To consider written proposals, if any received by the Secretary.

The Secretary Sri. K.J. Devendrappa placed before the AG Body, the three letters from the honorable members(1) Secretary, Regional Chapter, Chitradurga, (2) Sri.K.J.Manjappa and (3)Prof.V.Veerabhadraiah regarding increasing the strength / allocation of M.C. members, Districtwise / Dept.wise / Regionwise and Genderwise.

The President Dr. K.V. Sarvesh opened the subject for discussion and requested to offer suggestions. Senior IATians like Shobanamurthy, Kantharaj, Gurusiddaiah, Dr.Nadagoudar, Yelladahalli, Suresh, Udaykumar, Dr.Challaiah, Sampangi Reddy, Dr. T.K. Prabhakar Setty and others were actively participated in the discussions on the subject.

The suggestions emerged are as under:

- Agro-Input Industries to include under IAT
- NGOs to include under IAT.

Districtwise allocation for MC members.

- Agroclimaticwise representation.
- Departmentwise allocations.
- Women reservation.
- Percentage of M.C. members to total membership.
- Quota for the members regionwise based on life
- Increasing the strength of M.C. members.

Dr. B.S. Nadagoudar intervened and stated that, since the bylaws have to be amended, he suggested to form a working group among the M.C. members and to discuss the subject in detail and to come out with fresh proposals. The President agreed to his suggestions and said that the matter will be discussed in the Managing Committee.

(iv) The Secretary placed before the August Body the letter received by Dr. N.G. Raghumohan. Former Head and Principal Scientist, ICAR suggesting to provide the profile of candidates like age, experience, service, social contacts, their capabilities to run IAT so that better and competent candidate can be selected in the elections to the M.C. of IAT.

The subject was kept opened for discussion. After a brief discussion on the subject the President Dr. K.V. Sarvesh expressed that it is difficult to give the profile of a candidate by the sitting Managing Committee. However the President informed the August Body that the subject will be discussed in the M.C. and appropriate decision will be taken.

(v) The Secretary placed before the Annual General Body, the letter received from Sri.K.H.Seetharaama Reddy senior IATian from Chitradurga with suggestions to publish the Krishi Tantrajna once in two months as it is not being done. He also suggested to get the approval of Annual Budget with in one month of commencement of the financial year, instead of seeking approval at the fag end of the year.

Sri. Seetharama Reddy has further suggested to send invitations to all the life members of IAT for seminars/ lecture programmes, instead of restricting to Bangaloreans.

Some of the members present in the Annual General Body suggested to send the Krishi Tantrajna by email, in addition to the printed copies.

Dr. K.V. Sarvesh assured the August Body that an appropriate action will be taken on the points raised in the letter of Sri. Seetharama Reddy.

(vi) The Secretary placed before the August Body, the letter received from Sri. M.J. Arun with regards to starting of a Cultural Association of IAT members in the second floor of the existing building after erecting a light roof.

The subject was discussed at length and some of the members supported the issue and some have raised doubts in having cultural association in IAT and opined that, it becomes a major activity in the Technical Institute of this type.

At this point of discussion Dr.K.V.Sarvesh intervened and stated that, since the issue needs further discussion in the M.C., he assured the August Body that appropriate action will be taken after discussing the issue in the M.C. meeting,

Other subjects:

The following suggestions were made by some of the IATians.

- (I) Dr. M.M. Kailash and Sri. S. Narayana Swamy suggested to have cultural activities.
- (ii) Sri. Suresh suggested to give prominence to Health aspect of life members in addition to cultural
- (iii) Dr. T.K. Siddarame Gowda suggested that IAT and Alumni Association of UAS to coordinate in organizing the programmes.

(9) Address by the President:

Dr. K.V. Sarvesh in his Presidential address thanked all the IATians in their cooperation in the achievements of this M.C. under different subjects, to name a few are:

- (i) Interaction sessions of farmers, farmer leaders, scientists, marketing department etc.
- (ii) Implementation of Krishi Ankura programme.
- (iii) Lecture programmes
- (iv) Seminars at taluk/hobli levels
- (v) Building alterations.
- (vi) Organizing Video conference etc.

The President Dr. K.V. Sarvesh assured the members assembled in the AGM that, the suggestions of all the members will be considered favourably wherever possible and requested their cooperation in future also.

The President further informed the August body that alteration to the IAT's main building has been taken up as per the decision of the AGM and complimented the members of the Core Committee, for their sincere efforts in building alterations.

(10) Vote of thanks.

The Treasurer Sri.K.Krishnappa proposed the vote of thanks to all the members present in the Annual General Body besides the President, the M.C. members and the office staff in conducting the AGM systematically.

The President Dr.K.V.Sarvesh declared the 40th AGM closed.

INTERACTION SESSION



An interaction session with Farmers, Scientists and **Department officials on the Final Verdict of Cauvery Tribunal was** organized on 4th March 2013

IAT Bangalore had arranged an Interaction session with the farmers, scientists and the Departmental officials on the final verdict of Cauvery Tribunal at the conference hall of IAT on the 4th March 2013 at 11-00

A.M. The main speakers on the occasion were Capt. Raja Rao, Retired Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation and Secretary, Environment Department, Government of Karnataka, Sri. K. Boraiah, Progressive Farmer and member, Cauvery Kutumba, Gopalapura, Mandya district and Prof. Gubbaiah, Retired Agricultural Scientist, Mandya.

At the outset Vice-President Prof. V. Veerabhadraiah while welcoming the participants explained the purpose of calling the Interaction session.

Capt. Raja Rao while presenting the details of the verdict, said that both the States, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu have to accept the verdict of the Tribunal since it cannot be questioned even in the court. Capt. Raja Rao said that according to the report of Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal, Karnataka, particularly Mandya farmers have to cultivate only 40000 ha. of sugarcane by using Cauvery river water. As a result he said that Sugar Industry will suffer a lot. He suggested to change the cropping pattern, crop growing systems etc. Digging borewells along the nalas to tap Ground water to grow semi irrigated crops, System of Rice

Intensification(SRI) method of paddy cultivation etc. to be given top priority.

Capt. Raja Rao further suggested that the Government should think in the direction of diverting the west flowing rivers. He also suggested construction of barrages to store the water in order to improve the water table in the soils.

Sri. Boraiah, Progressive farmer and member of Cauvery Kutumba of Mandya stated that the farmers in Tamil Nadu are wise in utilizing the Cauvery Water judicially. He suggested that farmers of Karnataka in General, and Mandya farmers in particular to visit the Cauvery basin of Tamil Nadu and study the cropping pattern followed in that state and to implement the same in Mandya district. He also suggested that the farmers of both the states to settle the issue amicably without harming the farmers of both the states.

Prof. Gubbaiah, while speaking on the occasion appealed to the participants to appraise the farmers in the judicious use of water for the crops by following System of Rice Intensification(SRI) method of Paddy cultivation and to avoid wastage of water in the palas.

The meeting was presided over by Dr. B.K. Dharmarajan, Additional Director of Agriculture, Department of Agriculture, GoK, Bangalore. About 40 members, scientists, departmental officials, farmers besides media persons attended the Interaction Session. Sri. Anandakrishna, Chairperson, Agribusiness and Consultancy of IAT extended vote of thanks.

The first enrolment committee meeting was held at the office of Joint Director of Agriculture, Shimoga on 5th March, 2013 for enrolling the new members to the Institution of Agricultural Technologists and also organized a guest lecture on Management of Giant African Snail (*Achatina fulica*) and Black slug (*Laevicaulis alte*) as a mark of the enrolment committee programme at Shimoga.

Dr.D.Rajagopal, Vice-President and Chairman of the Seminar and Endowment sub-committee, IAT Bangalore who participated as Chief Guest explained the various objectives and activities of IAT its establishment, its branches and its functioning throughout Karnataka state. Further, he also delivered a lecture through PPT on the Management of Giant African Snail (Achatina fulica) and Black Slug (Laevicaulis alte) as polyphagous pests, their damaging symptoms on wide variety of field crops, ornamentals, plantation crops etc. An integrated pest management practices including cultural, mechanical, biological and chemical control measures were suggested to the technologists to combat these pests and requested the participants to transfer this technology to the farmers.
